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Sub: Route Alignment for laying One No. additional 3X300 Sq.Mtr. XLPE Cable from Rohtak Road to Shahzadawala Bagh 33/11 KV Sub Station

1.0 INTRODUCTION/BACKGROUND

1.1 Executive Engineer (Plg.)-I,DESU has submitted the above said route proposal to strengthen the Shahzadawala Bagh Sub Station to meet the growing power demand in the localities of Shastri Nagar-Shahzadawala Bagh. Total length of the route is 3.10 Km. Both the sub stations are existing at site. The route proposal has been shown in Drawing No.13/4453 of DESU submitted with the above said proposal.

2.0 HOUTE PROPOSAL

The route is proposed along the Rohtak Road & 2.1 Road No.40. R/W of Rohtak Road and Road No.40 are 61M. as per the MPD-2001. The available R/W of Robtak Road varies between 24.5 Mtr. to 45.2 Mtr. as per the cross sections shown in the above said drawing. The 24.50 Mtr. R/W 44 above the bridges on Hajafgarh Drain. The entire route is proposed to be laid below the F/P portion leading 0.5M to 1.50M. from the edge available R/W of Road No.40 is 47.5M. as against the proposed 51M. Existing R/W below the Zakhira Flyover proposed is 51M. In this stretch also the cable is proposed to be laid below the F/P portion leaving 0.50M. to 1.50M. from the edge of the available R/W. As and when the full R/W is available in all these cross sections, most of the cable route shall be adjusted below the inner footpath portion or below the service road, and may not heed any shifting. The width & depth of the trench laying the cable shall be 0.50 Mtr.X1.50M.

2.2 Recently, a RUB has been constructed below the Delhi-Rohtak Road on Road No.40,DEBU may coordinate with Railways while laying cable route in this stretch. No. underground services, trees and structures are affected in the route proposal. DESU shall obtain permission of local bodies for any road cutting.

5.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

Sub: Route proposal for laying of 2 Nos. 3 X 300 sq.mm. XLPE cable from I.P. Station to proposed 33/11 HV S/Stn. at G.B. Pant Hospital: File No: F.6 (3)/94-M.P.

1.0 BACKGROUND/INTRODUCTION

2.1 Executive Engineer (Plg.)-I, DESU has submitted a revised proposal of the above said route alignment for laying of cable from I.P. Station to proposed 33/11 KV S/Stn. at G.B. Pant Hospital. The route shall feed the newly proposed S/Stn. at G.B. Pant Hospital. This shall augment the power supply to G.B. Pant Hospital complex and its surrounding. The route proposal has been shown in DESU's Drawing No.13/4454.

2.0 ROUTE PROPOSAL

2.1 The route starts from I.P. Station and after crossing the Ring Road it is taken along internal road of I.P. Complex in the South of Azad Ehawan; then passing along the Nallah upto Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg. After crossing the Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, it is taken along Deen Dayal Updhayay Marg upto School lane flyover. Thereafter, it is taken along the Maharaja Ranjit Singh Marg upto the road junction and then along Jahawar Lal Nehru Marg upto the proposed S/Stn. 33/11 KV at G.B. Pant Hospital. In the I.P. Complex existing road R/W varies between 12 Mtr. to 16 Mtr. The existing R/W of Deen Dayal Updhayay Marg is 33M, the existing R/W of Maharaja Ranjit Singh Marg is 37M. which includes the School Lane flyover also. The existing R/W of J.L. Nehru Marg is 34.5 Mtr. The Road R/W in the I.P. Complex are not defined in any of the plans. The R/W of D.D.U.

Marg Maharaja Raujit Singh Marg and J.L. Nehru Marg are 45M., 30M., and 36M. respectively as per MPD-2001 proposal.

- 2.2 The entire cable route is proposed underground. The cables are proposed to be laid at a depth of 1.2M. below the F/P portion along the existing cables. The cables do not foul with any of the underground services in the area. No structure, trees, U/G services are affected in the proposal. As all the cables are proposed underground below the F/P, along the Nallah, DDA does not have any objection from Flanning point of view. DESU has already started construction of the S/Stn. Building at G.B. Pant Hospital.
- 2.3 As the cable road involves in crossing various important and busy road, DESU shall obtain permission from the local bodies/agencies before taking up the work.

3.0 AUDIOMERUDATION

3.1 The case is put up to the Technical Committee for approval of the underground route as explained under para 2.1

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Sub: Route Alignmentfor laying 4 Nos. 3X300 Sqm. KIPE Cable from Naraina 220/33 KV Sub Stn. to Inderpuri DMS Sub Station near Loha Mandi Naraina: (File No. F.6(5)/95-M.P.:

1.0 INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

1.1 Executive Engineer (Plg.)-I,DESU has submitted the above proposal for strengthing the power supply at Inderpuri and DMS 33/11 KV grid sub-station to meet the growing demand of power of these areas. The total length of the route is 3.55 km. The entire route is proposed to be laid underground. The route proposal is shown in DESU's Drawing No.13-4452.

2.0 ROUTE PROPOSAL

The route starts from the existing 220 KV sub 2.1 station along Ring Road in Cantonment Area. The route is taken along Ring Road and Maraina Road upto Loha Mandi Crossing. The R/W of Ring Road and Naraina Road are 64 Mtr. and 30.5 Mtr. respectively as per MPD-2001. The available R/W on Ring Road is 60.02 Mtr. in-front-of the sub station. In the stretch passing through Naraina Village, the available R/W is varying from 17.1 Mtr. near Maraina Vill. to 26.60 Mts. near Naraina Road 'T' Junction. Available R/W on Maraina Road is 28.5 Mtr. The cables are proposed to be laid below the footpath at a depth of about 1.20 Mtr. leaving 0.50 Mtrs. to 1.5 Mtr. from the edge of the existing R/W. The width of the existing footpath is varying between 2 Mtr. to 3.5 Mtr.

The proposed underground route shall not foul with any of the existing underground services in the area. As and when the full road R/W is made available, the cable except in the Naraina village portion can be adjusted below the footpath/service road area.

New power connections shall be given to the persons having approved building plans and proper valid licence for industrial/household writs. Ho trees, underground services and structures are affected in the proposal.

3.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

3.1 The case is put-up to the Technical Committee for approval of the underground route as explained under para 2.1

Sub: Proposal for construction of an 'elevated road' on Mathura Road (NH-2) in the stretch passing through Badarpur Village, Mehrauli Badarpur Road T' junction and Jaitpur Road T' junction:

1.0 Introduction and Backbround:

1.1 Supdt. Engineer (Plg.) fly-over Project, PWD vide letter dated 19th May,95 has submitted the above said proposal for consideration of DDA. Location plan is placed as Annexure-I. In the letter, it is mentioned that the Ministry of Surface Transport has identified the above said proposal as an important one due to increase in traffic. It is further stated in the letter that the Ministry has included this scheme in their 9th Five Year Plan. The proposal has been got prepared through a private Consultancy Firm.

1.2 Master Plan/Zonal Plan Proposals

1.2.1 The Right-of-ways on Mathura Road (NH-2) and Mehrauli-Badarpur Road as per MPD-2001 are 45.72 Mts. (150') and 76.02 Mtr. (250') respectively. Jaitpur Road is a local road. Mehrauli-Badarpur Road in this stretch meeting with the NH-2 is to form part of the proposed 'urban expressway'. No grade separator is envisaged at this 'T' junction in MPD-2001 as also in the priority grade separators discussed and finalised in meetings under Chief Secretary on 9/9/1992 and 17/12/1993.

1.2.2 In MPD-2001, a 91 Mtr. (300') R/W

NH-2 Bye-pass is proposed from Maharani
Bagh upto Haryana Border. This bye-pass
shall continue in the Haryana side, a link
road to Mathura Road (NH-2) at a distance
of about 0.80 Km.fromMehrauli-Badarpur 'T'
junction is proposed. A conceptual alignment plan of the bye-pass road was submitted by PWD and the same had been approved
by DDA's Technical Committee Meeting. Detailed plan is awaited from PWD.

2.0 Details and Examination

2.1 Problems:

- 2.1.1 At present the regional traffic from Central/
 South Delhi destined to Haryana is using the
 Mathura Road (NH-2). In the stretch of
 Lathura Road (NH-2) passing through Badarpur
 Village there is a delay on account of contineous ribbon development with spillover
 activities on road which causes hindrance to
 free flow of traffic, depart from the two
 'T' junctions.
- iageway, 8 lane divided carriageway is existing on Mehrauli-Badarpur Road. This 'T' junction is presently controlled by traffic signals. As per the traffic volume survey conducted by the Consultants, 5379 PCU's are using this inter-change during peak hours presently. This is expeted to increase to 8316 PCUs by the Year 2001 and to 19,361 PCUs by 2015, as per the estimated growth as per studies conducted by Consultants.

Length of Mathura Road (NH-2) between Ashram Chowk and
Delhi-Haryana Border is 10 kms. There are 5 signalised
junctions/intersections in the stretch apart from entry/
exit to Appello Hospital, Sarita Vihar, Friends Colony etc.

2.2 PROPOSALS.

- 2.2.1 The volume of straight traffic on Mathura Road (NH-2) is 3123 PCU's. The right turning traffic from Mathura Road to Mehrauli-Badarpur is 525 PCU's. The right turning traffic from Mehrauli-Badarpur Road to Mathura Road (NH-2) is 684 PCU's and the rest 1047 PCU's account for left turning traffic from different areas. Average delay during peak period is of seconds.
- Keeping in view the existing problems and the traffic 2.2.2 volume projected at Mehrauli-Badarpur Road junction, PwD has submitted an elevated road proposal covering the Badarpur Village, Mehrauli Road and Jaitpur Road 'T' junctions. The total length of the elevated road is 1.689 Kms. This proposal was prepared after considering three alternative proposals. Comparative features of alternatives-I, II & III are placed as Annexure-II. Alternative II has been considered to be preferred solution. Six lane divided (11M on either side of central verge of 1.20M) continuous flyover is proposed with 9M wide read for local traffic on either sides at surface level. 1.50M wide footpath are proposed on either sides. Pedestrian subway is proposed on the northern side of Mehrauli-Badarpur read. The proposal has been prepared in the available about 35M to 50M R/W by affecting minimum number of structures. At places where the R/W is less, part of the surface roads have been taken below the flyever.

2.3 OBSERVATIONS.

- 2.1.1 Proposal of grade separator on any junction/intersection must consider the existing/proposed planning proposals along the stretch.
- 2.3.4 The stretch of Mathura Road (NH-2) from Badarpur Village to Faridabad Border is in a peculiar state because of the following reasons:-
- The slope of existing road under bridge below the railway lines on Mehrauli-Badarpur Road is just ending at the junction of Mathura Koad (NH-2).
- There are a large number of structures of Badarpur Village and its extension just at the junction of Mehrauli-Hadarpur Road.
- c) All along this junction, there is a spilover of activities from the adjoining unauthorised structures. This has made the movement of the traffic difficult and is also causing delays.
- d) There is a junction of Mehrauli-Badarpur Road with Mathura Road (NH-2) which is forming part of the expressway proposal.
- e) There is a junction of road leading to Jaitpur which is meeting with Mathura Road (NH-2).
- There is proposed junction of Link road connecting NH-2 by epass with Mathura Road at a distance of 0.80 km. from the Mehrauli-Badarpur road junction.
- Faridabad border is just 400M away from the proposed link road junction mentioned above.
- Considering the Master Plan proposals, after the construction of NH-2 byepass, the entire bye-passable traffic destined to Faridabad, Agra and further on, shall use the byepass. The junction of Mehrauli-Badarpur road with Mathura Road (NH-2) should be given preference so that the traffic to and from Mehrauli Badarpur Road (which is

forming part of the expressway) should be able to take free movements without any signalisation. This is not possible due to the site constraints mentioned above.

2.3.6 Considering the fact that Mathura Read (NH-2) shall continue to attract large number of vehicles due to the strong corridor on the scuthern side as also the junction of Mehrauli-Badarpur read which is forming part of the expressway, the traffic en this stretch shall continue to increase. Under the circumstances, two alternatives could be possible.

ALTERNATIVE-I.

Mathura Read may fly above the congested stretch abutting Badarpur Village, Mehrauli-Badarpur read and Jaitpur road junctions. In this case, the ending point of flyover shall be just 200M from the proposed Link Read Junction.

ALTERNATIVE-II.

Mathura Road may fly above M.B.Road, Jaitpur Road and proposed Link Road junction. In this case the ending point of the flyover shall be just 140M away from the Border which may not be desirable.

From the above, it shall be seen that the elevated proposal to cover part of Badarpur village, Mehrauli-Badarpur read and Jaitpur road may be a better proposal. The junction of Link Road connecting NH-2 byepass and NH-2 may have to be treated as a left-in and left-out road as it will be hardly 140M away from the end of the slope of proposed elevated food. The right turning movements from Link Road may be taken below the flyover. The proposal submitted by PWD may be suitably modified and resubmitted with the detailed feasibility.

5.0 RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

- j.1 It is recommended that the alternative-I proposal as per para 2.3.6 may be considered.
- 3.2 The case is put-up to Technical Committee for consideration of :-
 - (a) Alternative-I proposal recommended under para 2.3.6.
 - (b) PWD may be requested to expedite to obtain necessary clearances for NH-2 bye-pass proposal and its construction.

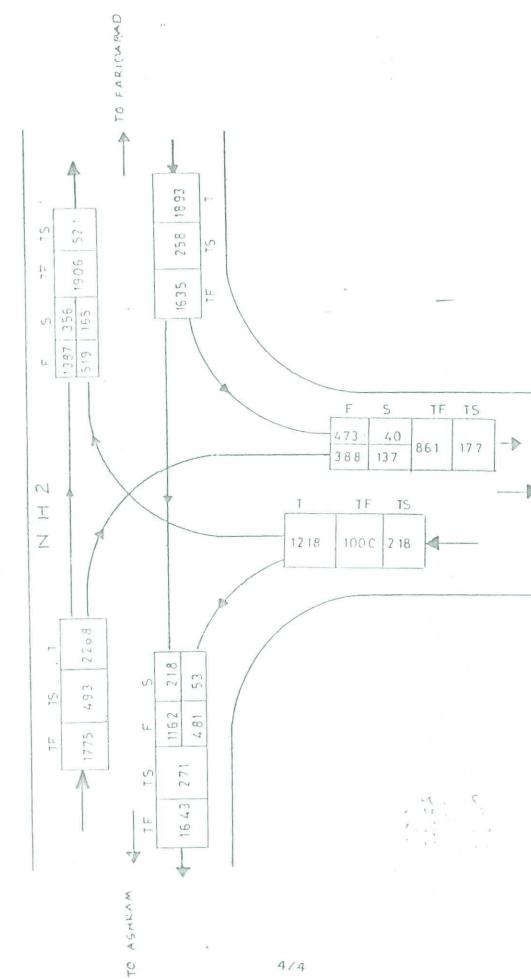

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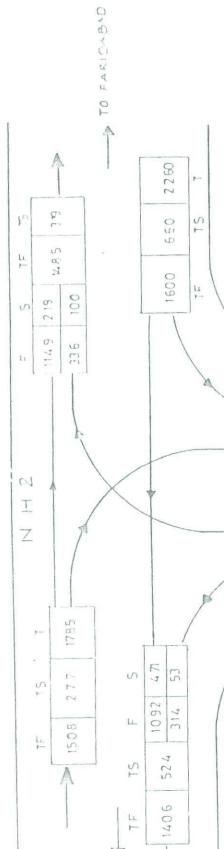

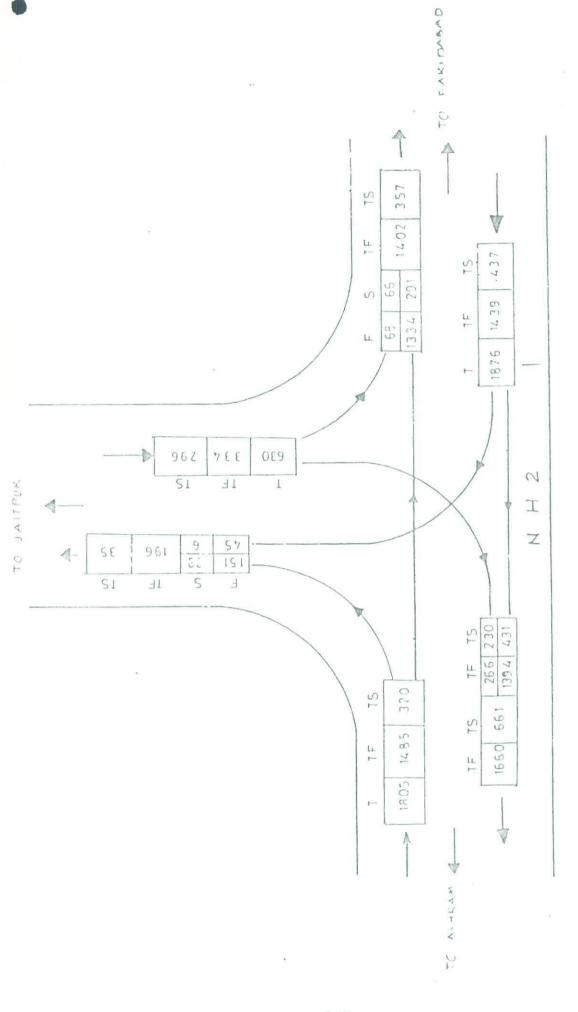

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Request of Delhi Orthodox Syrian Church Society for NCC regarding change of land use of existing "Primary School" in 2.0 Acre site in Safdarjung Development Area in "Secondary School": Policy
File No. PA/JD(AP)/I/95/D-106.

1.0 BACKGROUND

- The Chairman of Delhi Orthodox Syrian Church Society has requested for change in the use of existing primary school site to Secondary school level functioning in 2.02 Acres (0.82 Hec.) site in C-3, Safdarjung Development Area.
- 1.2 The case was considered in the Technical Committee meeting held on 23.1.96 vide item no. 13/96/TC, the decision of which is reproduced below: -

"After detailed discussion, it was observed that all the involved merits and demerits of the proposal be highlighted, such as area norms, location, requirement, approach road/traffic and other related aspects. Item be brought up again in the Technical Committee next month."

2.0 DETAILED EXAMINATION

2.1 The society was allotted 2.02 acres (0.82 Hec.) site earmarked for primary school in the layout plan of Hhimnagri Safdarjung Residential Block-'C' for the construction of primary school in July,1967. In the letter u/r the Chairman of the society has stated that necessary approvals for upgradation of the existing primary school to the level of Senior Secondary School have already been obtained by the society from the Directorate of Education. The society is also affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education. The Chairman has stated that the building plans for creating additional space for accommodating a total of around 1800 students was submitted to MCD but the MCD has, instead, desired a NOC from DDA regarding change of land-use from primary to secondary school.

- 2.2 As per MFD-2001 sites measuring 4.0 Acres (1.6 Ha.) could be considered for allotment for Sr.Secondary Schools (Class VI to XIIth) for 1000 students whereas for integrated schools without hostel facility (Class I to XIIth) for 1500 students sites measuring around 9.0 Acre (3.5 Hac.) could be considered for allotment. The comparate planning standards and development controls for various category of schools Vs the existing school of the society u/r are given on overleaf.(Annexure-'A').
- Presently, an integrated school from Class-I to Class XII of 1800 students is functioning in an area of around 2.0 Acres as against the Master Plan requirement of around 9.0 Acres. Begarding the request of the society for creating additional space by getting the existing primary school upgraded, it has been observed that by getting the primary school upgraded to Sr.Sec.School level, the total FAR, instead of getting increased, gets reduced from existing 4104 Sq.mtr. to 3694 Sq.mtr. only i.e. a net loss of 410 Sq.mtr. The total FAR further gets reduced to only 1970 Sq.mtr. i.e. a net loss of 2134 Sq.mtr. by getting the existing primary school upgraded to the level of integrated school which is, in fact, functiong.
- The request of upgradation of school on the basis of uparadation certificates issued by Directorate of Education
 and later getting the school affiliated to CBSE is a common
 phenomenon in the entire urban Delhi and is a matter of
 policy which will also involve modification in the layout
 plan in addition to the application of different planning
 standards and development controls. Also recently in
 response to the objections/suggestions received from the
 public for the finalisation of draft Zonal Plans, the
 residents of the colonies have objected to showing the
 carlier primary school sites for Sr.Sec./Integrated School.

The floor space ground coverage etc. permitted on a plot are governed by the size of the plot and conditions of layout. The upgradation of the primary school to Sr.Sec./
Integrated School level is also involved modifications in the approved layout plan. The school is located on a 45 ft. wide road ending in Oul-de-Sac about 200 mtrs. from the main Aurobindo Marg. Preferably the Sr.Secondary School should be located on 60° and 80° wide roads.

3.0 RECOMMENDATIONS/SUGGESTIONS

- a) Since the school is already functioning as an integrated school the case is that of fait-accompli.
- b) Provision of MPD norms of FAR in such a case results in a very high building volume in land component ratio thereby having a very high intensity of floor space and activity.
- c) As given at (a) and (b) the generation of traffic and related activities would effect the environment of the neighbourhood.
- d) At the time of processing of zonal plan there have been objections with regards to certain schools which are functioning at higher levels than prescribed.

In view of the above, the matter is placed before the Technical Committee.

1. LCKGROUND

The request of Chief Architect for locating the 66-K.V. S/Station in lieu of its proposal for District Centre Saket. The development of which is at the final stage was discussed in the Technical Committee Meeting held on 12.3.96 and the decision of the Technical Committee is reproduced below:

"Technical Committee approved the alternative-I, located near Shivalik CHBS for 66-KV grid sub-station (90 mtr.x120 mtrs. approximately). The land use of the site under reference is district parks and is undeveloped/free of trees. As per MPD-2001, public utilities including power are permitted in all use zones."

2. EXAMINATION

In pursuance of the above decision of the Technical Committee F.I. Survey of the site was got conducted and it is observed that a small nursary alongwith a temple and samadi was existing within a corner of the site. Also an old monument known as "Vijay Mandal" is existing adjoining the site. A High Tension Line is passing through a small portion of the site near the T. Junction. Two tubewells near the boundary wall/grill between this site and old monuments are also existing.

3. PROFOSAL

Since the old monument is of historical importance, it is proposed to leave around 30 mtrs. space between the monument and the proposed 66-K.V. ESS. Also the area where a temple, samadi and nursary are existing is proposed to be left in one corner of the site. After leaving, this site measures around 112-mtrs. towards the old monument side and 111.2 mtrs. towards the 80 ft. wide road leading to Gitanjali Enclave - Lok Sewak CHBS. The balance entire land which works out to 8250 sq.mtrs. is proposed to be utilised for 66-K.V. ESS.

Allotment of land for establishment of 33 KV Grid Sub. Stn. at Rani Bagh. (File No. PA/Dir.(AP)-II/95/745)

1.0 BACKGROUND

DESU vide thier letter no. SE(Plg.)II:28:256 dt. 18.1.96 requested for allotment of land for the establishment of 33KV Grid Sub/stn. at Rani Bagh. Earlier the q request was not agreed since DDA had already allotted land in H-4-5 in Pitampura which is close to Rani Bagh. However, in a meeting held in the room of Chief Engr.(Elect.),DDA, it has been pointed out by the officials of DESU that this grid station is required to meet the load requirement of the complex of Rani Bagh unauthorised colonies. To resolve the matter a joint inspection was held with representatives of DESU so as to examine the possibilities of locating the Grid Sub/Stn. on the site for which land was identified by DESU.

2.0 DETAILED EXAMINATION

The site suggested by DESU for the Grid Sub/Stn. is shown as NHP in the plan of Shivalik CHBS and, therefore, has not been considered. Just close/abutting it is the land of District Park through which 33 KV line is passing. As per site a nallah is also in existence in the south of the District Park. The site is located on 60 ft. R/W road (18 mtr.) and has large number of trees with a boundary wall upto the nallah which is passing through the land of District Park. Beyond nallah in the west the land is lying vacant. This site is proposed for the construction of 33 KV Grid Sub/stn.

3.0 PROPOSAL

The land out of the District Park and bounded by HT line in the North, covered drain(nallah) in the South and East and District Park in the West is proposed for the 33KV Grid Sub/Stn. To provide an approach to the Grid Sub/Stn. land between the HT line at pole no. 47 and the existing boundary wall in the south is also proposed for this sub/stn. as an approach road. This will also save the land form possible encroachment. Approx. land area is 3375 Sq.mt. as indicated red on the copy of PT survey of the site.

4.0 RECOMMENDATION

The case is submitted for consideration and approval of the Technical Committee.
