15 South Delhi Roads To Go Under The Knife

Lakhs Of Commuters To Benefit, Says Sisodia

New Delhi: Deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia on Monday approved a project to repair 15 main roads in south Delhi. The total length of the roads, which have been selected for strengthening, is about 18.2 kilometres.

The roads that will be taken up for repair work include Bipin Chandra Marg, EPDP Road, Hansraj Sethi Marg, Baba Fateh Singh Marg, Maharaja Agrasen Marg, Kanshi Ram Takkar Marg, Hansraj Gupta Marg, BRT to Hansraj Gupta Marg, B-76 to B-111, Greater Kailash-1, Asian Village Road, NIFT Road, Subhash Chopra Road, August Kranti Marg, Gurdwara Road and DDA Market Road. The cost of the project is Rs 23.2 crore.

Sisodia has been emphasising on road maintenance work ever since he was made the Public Works Department minister. "We are working in a phased manner to develop roads across the national capital. The last time these roads were strengthened was several years ago and over the years, the load of vehicles has increased on them. Due to this, cracks have appeared on the top surface of the roads," he said.


"This is the cause of inconvenience for commuters at many places and restricts the movement of vehicles too. These are some of the important roads in the city and taking cognisance of their situation, we

are starting the work of strengthening the roads immediately in south Delhi. This will benefit lakhs of commuters taking these routes everyday," added the PWD minister.

Earlier, the Delhi government had approved three similar road repair projects in different parts of the city. Sisodia said that chief minister Arvind Kejriwal's vision is to provide roads as per global standards to commuters of

Delhi. For this, along with strengthening of the roads, the department is also paying special attention to proper road markings, signage, and other infrastructure.

दक्षिणी दिल्ली की 15 प्रमुख सड़कों की सुधरेगी दशा, 23.24 करोड़ होंगे खर्च

राज्य ब्यूरो, नई दिल्ली : दिल्ली सरकार 23.24 करोड़ रुपये खर्च कर 15 प्रमुख सड़कों की दशा सुधारेगी। ये सड़कें दक्षिणी दिल्ली के तहत चार विधानसभा क्षेत्रों में आती हैं। इसमें कालकाजी, ग्रेटर कैलाश, मालवीय नगर व कस्तूरबा नगर विधानसभा शामिल हैं। इन सड़कों की कुल लंबाई 18.19 किलोमीटर है। उपमुख्यमंत्री मनीष सिसोदिया सरकार ने सोमवार को इन सड़कों के लिए बजट की मंजूरी दे दी है।

सिसोदिया ने कहा कि हम क्रमबद्ध तरीके से पीडब्ल्यूडी के अंतर्गत आने वाली सड़कों को बेहतर बना रहे हैं। पिछली बार इन सड़कों की मरम्मत का कार्य कई वर्ष पहले हुआ था। इस दौरान सड़कों पर वाहनों का भार काफी बढ़ा है, जिससे सड़कों की ऊपरी सतह पर दर्रें आई गई हैं। इस पर तुरंत संज्ञान लेते हुए सरकार द्वारा इन चारों विधानसभा क्षेत्र की सड़कों की मरम्मत का कार्य शुरू किया जा रहा है। दिल्ली सरकार का कहना है कि सुदृढ़ीकरण के इस प्रोजेक्ट में सड़कों की मजबूती पर तो ध्यान दिया ही जाएगा। साथ ही इन सड़कों पर सभी मानकों का पालन करते हुए अच्छी गुणवत्ता की रोड मार्किंग भी की जाएगी। इन सड़कों की मरम्मत के लिए पीडब्ल्यूडी दिल्ली आधुनिकतम तकनीक का उपयोग कर रहा है, ताकि सड़कें यात्रियों की आवाजाही के लिए अधिक सुरक्षित बन सकें।

इन सड़कों का जीर्णोद्धार : दक्षिणी दिल्ली की जिन सड़कों की मरम्मत होगी, उनमें हंसराज सेठी मार्ग, बाबा फतेह सिंह मार्ग, महाराजा अग्रसेन मार्ग, कांशीराम मार्ग, हंसराज गुप्ता मार्ग, बीआरटी से हंसराज गुप्ता मार्ग, बी-76 से बी-111, ग्रेटर कैलाश-पार्ट-एक, एशियाई गेम्स विलेज रोड, एनआइएफटी रोड, सुभाष चोपड़ा रोड, अगस्त क्रांति मार्ग, बिपिन चंद्रा मार्ग, गुरुद्वारा रोड, ईपीडीपी रोड, डीडीए मार्केट रोड शामिल हैं।

15 key roads in south Delhi set for ₹23cr upgrade: Govt

NEW DELHI: Deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia on Monday said the Delhi government has approved road strengthening projects, estimated to cost ₹23.24 crore, and the state public works department will carry out work on 15 stretches across south Delhi in the coming months.

Roads totalling a length of 18.19km are to be repaired and strengthened under the project, and will include stretches in Kalkaji, Greater Kailash, Malviya Nagar and Kasturba Nagar, officials said.

Sisodia, who also holds the PWD portfolio, said the department was working in a phased manner and these projects will ensure that lakhs of commuters benefit in terms of saving on fuel costs and travel time. The 15 identified roads include Hansraj Sethi Marg, Baba Fateh Singh Marg, Maharaja Agrasen Marg, Kanshi Ram Takkar Marg, Hansraj Gupta Marg, BRT to Hansraj Gupta Marg, Asian Games Village Road, August Kranti Marg and Bipin Chandra, among others.

Sisodia also said the PWD is using advanced technology for strengthening road stretches and following global standards of street design. "Along with strengthening roads, the department is also paying special attention to proper road markings, signages, and other road infrastructure. This will help the Delhi government make city roads safer and provide a pleasant experience to commuters of Delhi," he said.

Govt okays projects worth Rs 23.24 crore to strengthen roads

NEW DELHI: Delhi government has approved projects worth Rs 23.24 crore for the strengthening of 15 roads in south Delhi areas, including Kalkaji, Greater Kailash, Malviya Nagar and Kasturba Nagar, Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia said on Monday.

The projects will provide relief from traffic jams to lakhs of commuters and help save their time and fuel, said Sisodia who is also the Public Works Department (PWD) minister of Delhi.

"The PWD is using advanced technology and global standards of street design to make roads of the national capital world-class," he said.

The total length of the roads selected for strengthening is 18.19 km, officials said.

These include Hansraj Sethi Marg, Baba Fateh Singh Marg, Maharaja Agrasen Marg, Kan-

shi Ram Takkar Marg, Hansraj Gupta Marg, BRT to Hansraj Gupta Marg, Asian Games Village Road, NIFT Road, August Kranti Marg, and DDA Market Road among others.
