HON'BLE LT. GOVERNOR DELHI CHAIRS AUTHORITY MEETING, **APPROVES FESTIVAL HOUSING SCHEME 2023**

The Delhi Development Authority (DDA) in its meeting chaired by Lt. Governor, Shri V.K. Saxena, who is also Chairman, DDA, approved launching of Festival Special Housing Scheme 2023, with more than 32,000 flats of different categories at various locations such as Dwarka, Loknayak Puram and Narela, on 15.11.2023. The Authority Meeting was attended by Vice Chairman, DDA and other members.

The scheme has the following main features:

- The flats are being offered under this i. scheme through 2 different modes i.e., e-Auction and First Come First Serve (FCFS) basis as per their location.
- ii. All the flats offered are newly constructed.
- iii. DDA for the first time is offering more than 1100 luxury flats. These include penthouses, super HIGs and HIGs at Dwarka 19B overlooking the

upcoming golf course of DDA. All these flats will be offered through e-Auction.

- iv. Besides, the MIG flats at Sector 14, Dwarka and Loknayakpuram which is 316 and 647 in numbers respectively will also be offered through e auction mode.
- v. 728 EWS Flats in Sector 19 B, Dwarka, 316 LIG and 1008 EWS flats in Sector 14 offered in different tranches/phases.
- vi. A person can book a flat of one's choice in his preferred locality and floor instantly by paying the booking amount.
- vii. There is no conditionality of owning any plot / house in Delhi for booking of these extended family for enabling improved urban living.
- viji. EWS Flats start from Rs 11.5 Lakh, LIG from Rs 23 Lakh, MIG from Rs 1 crore, HIG onwards.
- ix. The entire process from application to allotment and possession is being done through online mode at DDA website.

The LG also administered a pledge - Viksit Bharat Sankalp - to all the dignitaries and people present on the occasion and flagged off IEC (Information, Education and



Communication) vans to disseminate information about the schemes. Kiosks of DDA, banks, postal department, UIDAI, Union Petroleum and Natural Gas ministry and postal department were also put up, highlighting various government of India schemes.

- A. Reaching the unreached reach out the vulnerable who are eligible under various schemes but have not availed benefit so far.

- C. Learning from the citizens Interaction with beneficiaries of government schemes through personal stories/experiences sharing.
- D. Enrolment of potential beneficiaries through details ascertained during the Yatra.

INAUGURATION OF ILLUMINATED CHIMNEY TOWER AT RAJGHAT POWER PLANT BY HON'BLE LT. GOVERNOR DELHI



On the eve of Diwali, Delhi got another significant lighted landmark on its skyline on 10.11.2023, with Lt. Governor, Shri VK Saxena inaugurating the illumination of 166 meters Chimney Tower at Rajghat Power Plant, making it the tallest illuminated structure of the National Capital. With the Qutub Minar in South Delhi, Pitampura TV Tower in North/West Delhi, this illuminated column of light will become the outstanding landmark for Central/East Delhi, about 9 months after Shri Saxena first visited it.

This is in line with Shri Saxena's commitment to beautify the National Capital by creating permanent assets and will serve as a new landmark of the ITO metropolitan

city centre, especially for the lakhs of people entering the central city area on a daily basis to and from across the River Yamuna. It also promises to unfold further surprises that are to be opened up subsequently, through refurbishment and adaptive reuse/repurposing of the Power Plant precinct.

Lying as an unseemly eyesore for the past more than 08 years, this chimney was being planned to be brought down and would have involved a huge cost, apart from causing avoidable dust pollution and adding substantially to the City's C&D waste dump. The Lt. Governor, Shri VK Saxena, who first visited the Rajghat Power Plant on 19.02.2023, had then asked for the chimney structure to be repurposed, so as to convert it into a permanent asset for the City and its residents.

Various meetings were held under the chairmanship of the Lt. Governor at Raj Niwas wherein it was decided that the repurposing of Rajghat Power House is to be taken up to showcase the power generation mechanism though a 5D experience for the public, making it a place for information and entertainment alike.

Compared to the 72.5m tall Qutub Minar which was recently illuminated and opened to the public, the Rajghat Power plant chimney, which is more than 2.2 times the height of Qutub Minar (with a base of 13m tapering up to 8m), posed technological challenges in lighting it up effectively. The illumination of the chimney tower has marked a significant presence of the capital's Skyline.

The Rajghat Power Plant, a coal-based plant spread over an area of 28 acres, was commissioned in 1989. However, it was decommissioned in 2015 due to pollution concerns.
