HON'BLE LT. GOVERNOR, SHRI VK SAXENA INAUGURATES 22 DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN SOUTH WEST DELHI VILLAGES UNDER DILLI GRAMODAYA ABHIYAN



In a significant step to enhance civic infrastructure and improve the quality of life in Delhi's villages, on 04.09.2024, Hon'ble Lt. Governor Shri VK Saxena inaugurated

Hon'ble LG, Shri VK Saxena inaugurates 22 developmental projects in 18 villages of South West Delhi under Dilli Gramodaya Abhiyan (DGA)

Under DGA, 552 works worth Rs 508 crore sanctioned so far, including 78 projects to be executed by DDA

35 works already completed with active involvement of various civic agencies under the aegis of DDA

Appropriate steps to eliminate the problems of roads, drains, sewers and water in Unauthorized Colonies soon - Hon'ble LG

22 development projects in 18 villages of South West Delhi under the Dilli Gramodaya Abhiyan. These projects included streetlights, road improvements, and renovation of community facilities, all planned in consultation with the local residents.

Additionally, the Namo Drone Didi Programme was launched to empower women and self-help groups. Shri Saxena emphasized that this initiative aligns with the Prime Minister's vision to enhance village infrastructure to city-level standards. DDA and other agencies are working actively to address rural challenges, with 552 works worth Rs 508 crore already sanctioned under this mission.



















FOUNDATION STONE LAID FOR 47 DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN NORTH DELHI VILLAGES



To enhance civic infrastructure in Delhi's villages, Hon'ble Lt. Governor Shri VK Saxena laid the foundation stone for 47 development projects worth Rs 45 crore in 29 villages of North Delhi on 10.09.2024 under the Dilli Gramodaya Abhiyan (DGA). On 04.09.2024, he had inaugurated 22 projects in 18 urbanized villages of South West Delhi, reflecting the rapid progress of the Abhiyan.

Hon'ble LG, Shri VK Saxena laid foundation stone of 47 developmental projects worth around Rs 45 crore in 29 villages of North Delhi under Dilli Gramodaya Abhiyan (DGA)

Under DGA, 573 works worth Rs 523 crore sanctioned so far

89 projects being executed by DDA

Various civic agencies like MCD, I&FCD, etc. are effectively implementing the Abhiyan under the aegis of DGA with funds provided by DDA

The Lt. Governor also inspected road, drain work, and cremation ground renovations at Singhu Village. The "Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam" plantation drive was carried out, and fruit saplings were distributed. Additionally, the Drone Didi program was launched to empower women.

Shri Saxena highlighted that these projects will transform rural life, bringing essential amenities to the villages. He also noted that the Namo Drone Didi Scheme, inspired by Hon'ble Prime Minister, aims to empower women and provide livelihoods.

Since its launch in December 2023, the DGA has sanctioned 573 works worth Rs 523 crore, including 89 DDA projects. Various projects such as the renovation of community spaces, road and drain development, and improvements in cremation grounds are underway across multiple villages.









HON'BLE LT. GOVERNOR, SHRI VK SAXENA ANNOUNCED OWNERSHIP RIGHTS FOR AGRICULTURAL LAND IN THE URBANISED VILLAGES OF DELHI



On the occasion of birthday (17.09.2024) of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Hon'ble Lt. Governor Shri VK Saxena announced the recording of ownership rights for agricultural land in urbanized villages of Delhi based on inheritance. This historic decision addressed a long-standing demand from residents who had been denied their inheritance rights since 2010, significantly impacting many lives.

During his visits to villages, Shri Saxena heard this demand from local residents and civic organizations. At a Samvaad at Raj Niwas, mutation of agricultural land emerged as a primary concern, supported by a delegation of all seven Delhi MPs.

Shri Saxena also laid the foundation stone for 41 new projects and inaugurated seven projects across 18 villages in North-West Delhi under the Dilli Gramodaya Abhiyan (DGA). He launched the Namo Drone Didi Scheme and introduced domestic PNG to 21 villages. He stated that the mutation process would begin promptly, with revenue authorities establishing camps in the villages soon.

Since its launch in December 2023, the DGA has aimed to improve living conditions in rural Delhi. Till date, 573 projects worth Rs 523 crore have been sanctioned, with approximately Rs 960 crore allocated for various development works. The initiative focuses on providing essential civic amenities and enhancing the quality of life in rural areas.

In a historic move, LG allows mutation of agricultural land in the urbanised villages of Delhi on the basis of inheritance.

Pending since 2010, this farreaching decision will address concerns and grievances of lakhs of Delhi residents and benefit them immensely.

Aanandita developed adjacent to Vijay Ghat, dedicated to the city

Two large rockery fountains, one fountain with columns, 18 corridor fountains, lit in tricolour

On 18.09.2024, Lt. Governor Shri VK Saxena dedicated Aanandita, the latest DDA Green initiative, to the people of Delhi. This project, aimed at enhancing greenery and aesthetics along the previously neglected Vijay Ghat stretch of the Samadhi Complex on Mahatma Gandhi Road, was personally envisioned and monitored by Shri Saxena.

Spanning approximately a kilometer along the Ring Road, Aanandita features two large rockery fountains, a columned fountain at an intersection, and 18 corridor fountains illuminated in tricolor. The design reflects the tranquil essence of the memorial complex, providing a space for reflection and remembrance.



The addition of the Fountain Corridor enriches the cultural and recreational landscape, creating an inviting environment for visitors. During the inauguration, the aesthetic design and thoughtful execution received praise from the Lt. Governor and other dignitaries.

Since assuming office, Shri Saxena has emphasized on enhancing greenery in Delhi, having recently inaugurated the Vaishnavi DDA Park at Ashok Vihar and developed projects like Asita East, Vasudev Ghat, and Baansera along the Yamuna bank.











AFFORDABLE HOMES, HIGH DEMAND: DDA'S HOUSING SCHEMES SPARK CITYWIDE EXCITEMENT



DDA launched three housing schemes on Raksha Bandhan, which saw a strong response. Over 1200 LIG and 440 EWS flats were sold in the Sasta Ghar and Madhyam Vargiya schemes. Rohini led the sales with all 708 LIG flats sold, while Narela booked 250 flats and Ramgarh saw 153 of 183 flats sold. In the EWS segment, 300 flats were sold in Narela, and all 139 flats in Loknayakpuram were booked.

DDA's ongoing housing scheme getting widespread response from home buyers- success led by affordable housing segment, pointing towards stabilizing mobility in aspirational EWS, LIG & MIG segments.

LG VK Saxena lauds DDA's efforts; reiterates commitment to priority housing for the poor.

All HIG flats in Jasola, LIG flats in Rohini, EWS flats in Loknayakpuram, Penthouse, Super HIG and HIG flats in Dwarka sold out.

Narela received encouraging response, more than 600 flats sold out. Narela to become education hub, new metro line connecting Rithala-Narela-Kundli in process.

Hon'ble LG Shri VK Saxena praised DDA's efforts and reaffirmed the commitment to affordable housing. On Day 1 of bookings, all HIG flats at Jasola were sold. Flats in Dwarka, including penthouses and super HIG units, also witnessed high demand, with flats selling well above the reserve price.

Narela, developed as an educational hub, saw promising growth with improved infrastructure, road networks, healthcare, and connectivity projects like the Rithala-Narela-Kundli metro corridor.

The success was attributed to DDA's efforts in offering affordable, quality


housing, enhancing green spaces, and ensuring cleanliness. Buyers were provided seamless information, including property documents within 24 hours. Prospective buyers could view flat details online for the first time.

While the Dwarka scheme has closed, the Sasta Ghar and Madhyam Vargiya schemes continue on a first-come-first-serve basis via DDA's website. All flats are ready-to-move-in, freehold properties.
